

# Election Guidelines Class of '13 Class Agent Elections

## General Info:

Class Agents will be elected during the Student Body Elections.

The contents of the packet handed out today should be reviewed carefully, and all of the appropriate forms returned to the Former Student Programs Office at The Association. A "Commitment to Serve" form must be signed by all team members and returned with your team essay and candidate's activities. **The deadline to return this information to Josh Reinbolt at [jreinbolt99@aggienetwork.com](mailto:jreinbolt99@aggienetwork.com) or Barb Lutz at [bbultz10@aggienetwork.com](mailto:bbultz10@aggienetwork.com) is February 10, 2012 at noon.**

You must also attend a mandatory candidates' meeting held by the Election Commission on **February 12** at 6:00 – 7:30 p.m. in Wehner 113 where you will receive additional election information. If have specific questions for the Election Commission you may address them at this time. Election Regulations must be followed. These regulations come from both the Election Commission and The Association of Former Students.

## Requirements / Rules for Running:

- All candidates must have a 2.0 overall GPA and be in good standing with the university.
- Each team must have three or four members.
- Each team member running for Class Agent must attend the Class Agent Pre-Election Informational Meeting held at The Association. The meeting time and place will be arranged by individual teams and Association staff.
- Each team member running for Class Agent must attend the Mandatory Candidates' Meeting held by the Election Commission on **February 12 in Wehner 113**.
- For each team, a "Commitment to Serve" as Class Agent form must be signed. Names should be listed on this form as they will appear on the ballot, both in order and name.
- A 150-word essay should be written by each team explaining to their Classmates why they should be elected as the 2012 Class Agents. Your team essay and picture will appear in the Election Issue of The Battalion.
- Each team must schedule a time to have their team picture taken at The Association.
- Each candidate is required to submit a list of major activities they have participated in while at A&M. Candidates should list these activities, as they would like them to appear in the Election Issue of The Battalion.

**The Association will pay the filing fees for each team.**

Results of the election will be released at the time of Student Body Elections as determined by the Election Committee.
