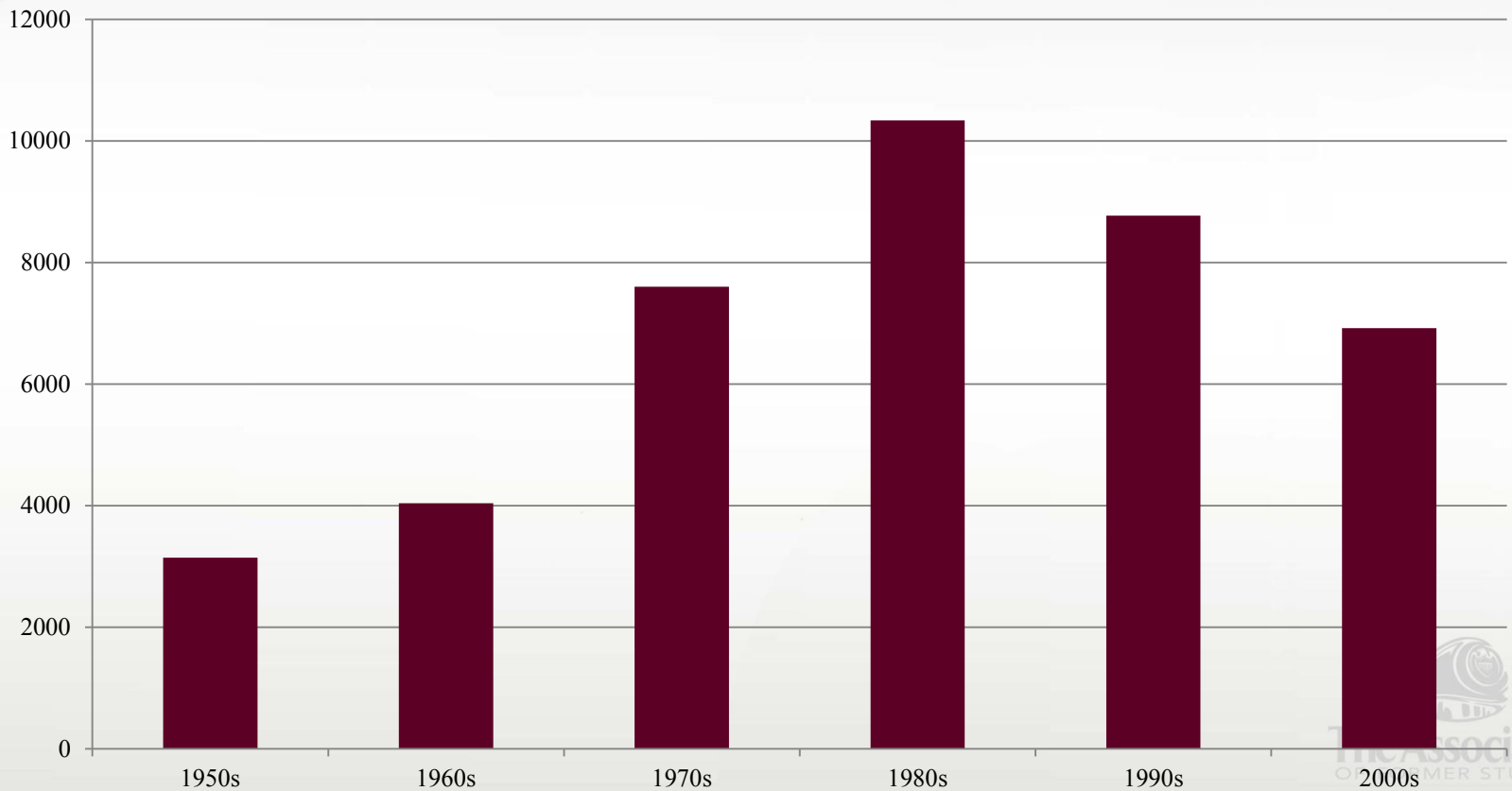

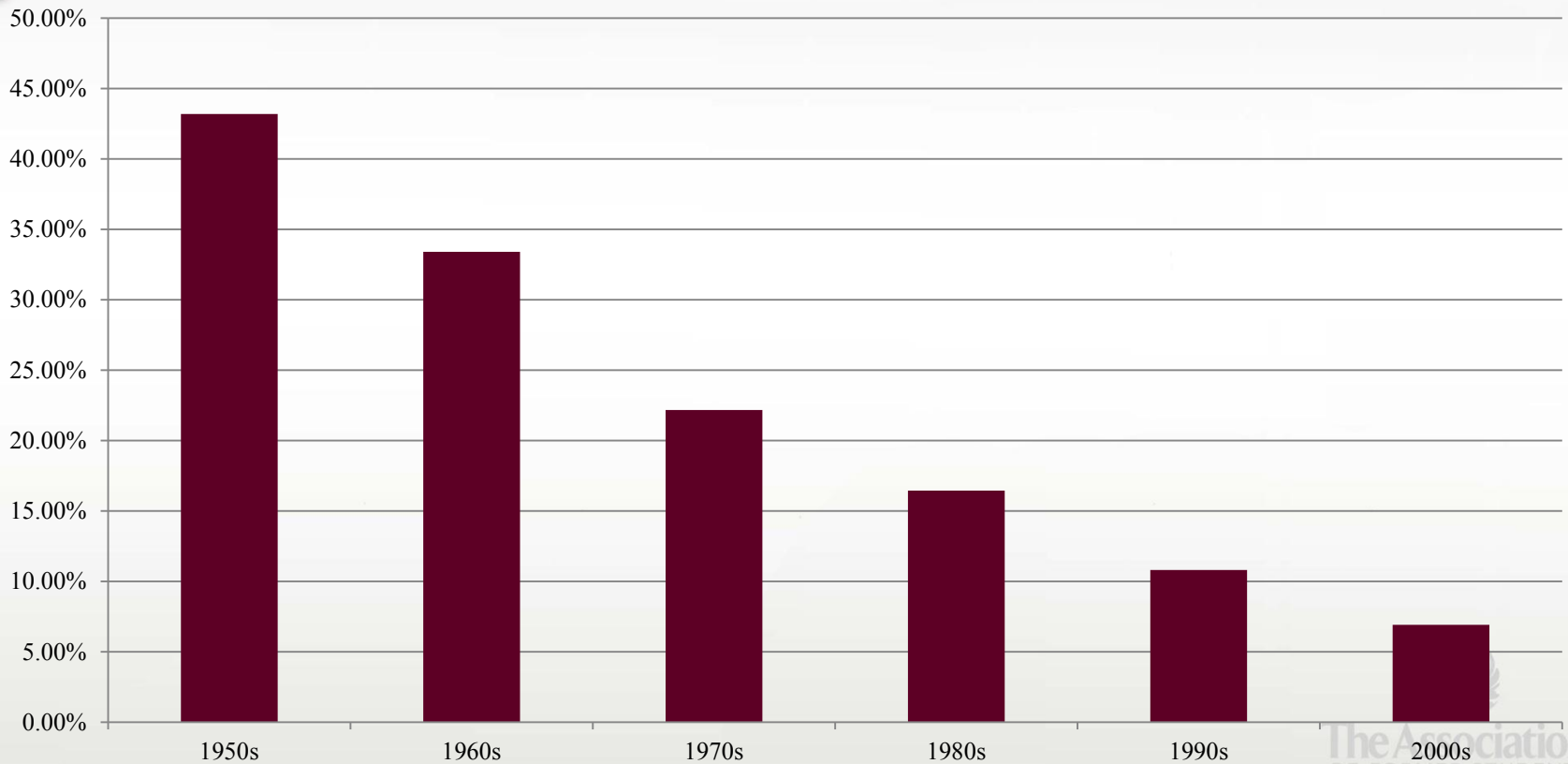
# Dollars by Decade
