## Educational Focus: Cortona and its Environs.

### **Excursion:** Walking Tour of Cortona.

Admire Cortona's exceptional Etruscan treasures from its perch of 600 meters above sea level. Stroll near charming piazzas, including the Piazza della Repubblica. Admire the 13th-century town hall, the cathedral and the 11th-century façade of the Diocesan Museum. See The Annunciation by Beato Angelico, and gaze at soul-stirring vistas from the town's ancient porta.

**Excursion:** *The Tuscan Countryside.* Travel through a patchwork of burgeoning hill country in the Val d'Orcia. Spy vineyards heavy with grapes and red poppy playgrounds peppered with church steeples. Tour a winery and sample local vintages and cheeses in the Brunello di Montalcino region.

### Educational Focus: Renaissance Art.

**Excursion:** *Siena.* Sitting on a lofty perch atop three hills, Siena is a treasure chest of Gothic architecture, cathedrals and museums. Visit the shell-shaped Piazza del Campo, the site of the bi-annual Palio horse race. Surrounding the piazza are the prominent Torre del Mangia, Piazza Chapel and Civic Museum. Step into

the Duomo, home to fascinating works of art and sculpture.

**Independent Exploration:** Enjoy time at leisure. Meander Siena's winding cobblestones, or sample two Sienese staples: panforte and ricciarelli.

### DAY FIVE FLORENCE

### **Excursion:** Cradle of the Renaissance.

From the birth of Michelangelo in 1475 to the death of the last Medici heir, Florence embodies a wealth of momentous Renaissance history. Explore the city center, a UNESCO World Heritage site, and discover how the city's caché of creative genius left it laden with fine art and stunning architecture around every turn. Walk by the Old Palace, the Ponte Vecchio, the Cathedral of Santa Maria del Fiore, the Piazza della Signoria and other highlights.

**Independent Exploration:** Explore the wonders and gastronomic pleasures of Florence on your own. Art lovers may choose to visit one of Florence's world-famous museums, the Uffizi or the Galleria dell'Accademia, home of Michelangelo's David.
