#### Day 1 – September 17 - Depart USA

#### DAY 2 - SEPTEMBER 18 - ARRIVE NAIROBI

Upon arrival at the Jomo Kenyatta International Airport, you will be met by Safari Legacy and transferred to your hotel for check in. Overnight **Ole Sereni Hotel.** (meals aloft)

#### DAY 3 - SEPTEMBER 19 - NAIROBI - SAMBURU GAME RESERVE

Morning drive via Nanyuki, crossing the equator to Samburu Game Reserve. Situated alongside the Ewaso Nyiro River, there is plenty to attract wildlife from the surrounding savannah plains. The reserve is rich in wildlife with an abundance of rare northern specialist species such as the Grevy's zebra, Somali ostrich, reticulated giraffe, gerenuk and the Beisa oryx (also referred to as Samburu Special Five). The reserve is also home to elephants and large predators such as the lion, leopard and cheetah. Wild dog sightings are also a common attraction to this unique protected area. Birdlife is abundant with over 450 species recorded. After lunch, enjoy an afternoon game drive. Overnight **Ashnil Samburu Tented Camp (BLD)** 

#### Day 4 – September 20 - Samburu Game Reserve

Full day in Samburu Game Reserve with morning and afternoon game drives. Samburu is inhabited by a wide variety of animals, more so the rare species such as the long- necked gerenuk, gravy's zebra, reticulated giraffe and Beisa Oryx. Other animals include leopard, lion, elephant, crocodile and hippo which can be seen swimming in the Ewaso Nyiro River. Overnight **Ashnil Samburu Tented Camp (BLD)** 

#### DAY 5 – SEPTEMBER 21 - SAMBURU – OL PEJETA CONSERVANCY

After breakfast enjoy a game drive en-route to Ol Pajeta Conservancy, a 90,000 acre private wildlife conservancy. Ol Pejeta is situated on the equator, in Kenya's Laikipia District, between the foothills of the Aberdares and the magnificent snow-capped Mount Kenya. The Ol Pejeta Conservancy boasts an astounding variety of animals, including the "Big Five" (endangered black rhino, leopard, elephant, buffalo and lion), Grevy's zebra, Jackson's hartebeest, cheetah and chimpanzee.

Overnight Sweetwaters Tented Camp (BLD)

#### Day 6 – September 22 - Ol Pejeta Conservancy & Jane Goodall Chimpanzee Sanctuary

Today enjoy a full day exploring the Ol Pejeta Conservancy with morning and afternoon game drives and a visit to the Jane Goodall Chimpanzee Sanctuary and the Rhino sanctuary. Overnight **Sweetwaters Tented Camp (BLD)** 

#### Day 7 - September 23 - Ol Pejeta - Lake Elmentaita

Morning drive to Lake Elmentaita, a soda lake, on the eastern side of East Africa's Great Rift Valley, about 120 km northwest of Nairobi, Kenya. In the south-to-north sequence of Rift Valley lakes, Elmenteita is located between Lake Naivasha and Lake Nakuru. At the southern end of the lake lie the "Kekopey" hot springs. The reed beds nearby are fishing grounds for Night Herons and Pelicans. Enjoy dinner and overnight at the **Lake Elementaita Luxury Camp (BLD)** 

#### DAY 8 – SEPTEMBER 24 - LAKE NAKURU NATIONAL PARK

Depart in the morning and drive to Lake Nakuru National Park, described by Roger Tory Peterson as the greatest ornithological spectacle in the world. Full day exploring Lake Nakuru National Park with picnic lunch. Overnight Lake Elementaita Luxury Camp (BLD)

#### DAY 9 – SEPTEMBER 25 – LAKE ELEMENTAITA / MAASAI MARA GAME RESERVE

This morning you will travel along the Rift Valley and ascend its western rim into the Maasai Mara Game Reserve. Known as the jewel of Kenya's wildlife viewing areas. The annual wildebeest's migration alone involves over 1.5 million animals between July and October. There have been some 95 species of mammals, amphibians and reptiles and over 400 birds species recorded on the reserve. Afternoon game drive. Overnight **Ashnil Mara Tented Camp (BLD)** 

#### Day 10 – September 26 - Maasai Mara Game Reserve

Full day with morning and afternoon game drives in the Maasai Mara. Overnight Ashnil Mara Tented Camp (BLD)

#### Day 11 - September 27 - Fly Maasai Mara Game Reserve / Nairobi

After breakfast, transfer to the grass airstrip for your <u>flight</u> back to Nairobi. Enjoy a farewell lunch at the Carnivore Restaurant. After lunch, enjoy dayrooms at the Ole Sereni Hotel or similar until your late afternoon transfer to the airport for your departing flights. (BL)

#### **Cancellation Policy**

All cancellations must be received in writing or by email and are effective upon receipt in our office. Cancellations received up to 90 days prior to departure will be refunded all monies less and administrative charge of \$150. Cancellations between 89 and 61 days prior to departure as assessed a penalty of 50% of the safari cost. Cancellations between 60 and 0 days prior to departure are assessed a penalty of 100% of the safari cost.

Some safaris may incur additional cancellation fees (**especially gorilla safaris**, **which gorilla permits are non-refundable**). There will be no refund for any unused portions of a safari once it has commenced. Cancellation penalties on airfares and gorilla permits are additional and may not be included in the above cancellation charges. Cancellation insurance for the total safari cost is strongly recommended.

#### Cancellation by Safari Legacy:

If the safari is canceled by Safari Legacy because of extraordinary conditions, all monies paid to Safari Legacy for land arrangements and internal flights if applicable will be refunded in full. Safari Legacy cannot accept responsibility for any other expenses incurred for preparing for the safari, including non-refundable airline tickets, passport or visa fees, etc...

#### **Our Published Rates:**

Changes in rates are rare, and caused by extraordinary circumstances outside Safari Legacy's' control. In the rare event that a cost should increase, cancellation is allowed without penalty prior to 90 days before departure. All prices are per person, based on double occupancy. All prices are subject to change.

#### **Travel Documents/Vaccinations:**
