COLOGNE PYC | Choose one of these excursions: • Cologne's Magnificent Cathedral. A

UNESCO World Heritage site, this awe-inspiring Gothic cathedral was under construction for more than 630 years. Marvel at this majestic structure from inside and out during your guided Old Town walking tour.

•Jewish Heritage Walk. Cologne's Jewish roots date to its founding by the Romans. Learn more about an active archeological project within the historic Jewish quarter before visiting the Cologne City Museum.

During your free time this afternoon, linger at the cheerfully decorated market stalls outside the cathedral, or head over to the Wallraf-Richartz Museum of Art or the Cologne Chocolate Museum.

Educational Focus: *The Tradition of the Holiday Markets.* Learn about Germany's unique Advent customs and the origins of the Christkindlmarkts.

This evening, the ship sails along the Rhine River to Koblenz.

DAY FOUR BILID KOBLENZ | RHINE GORGE

Excursion: *Koblenz.* More than 2,000 years ago, the Romans established a settlement at the



confluence of the Mosel and Rhine rivers. Today, beautiful Koblenz occupies this spot. During a walking tour, see the Church of Our Lady with its baroque towers; the Alte Burg, a 12th-century castle; and the Old Merchant's Hall.

The Rhine boasts more castles along its banks than any other river in the world. This afternoon, sail through the scenic Rhine Gorge, a UNESCO World Heritage site, en route to Miltenberg. Pass Loreley Rock, named after the siren of an old folk tale, whose song bewitched sailors and caused ships to crash into the rocks.

Excursion: *Miltenberg.* Take a guided walk through this picturesque medieval town, home to a 13th-century castle and timber-frame

houses lining cobbled streets. Then delight in the heartwarming sights and sounds of Miltenberg's festive market, while snacking on seasonal treats like roasted chestnuts and spiced pastries.

This evening, the ship sails to Würzburg.

DAY SIX

WÜRZBURG | ROTHENBURG

Excursion: *Würzburg.* This morning, walk through the regal rooms of the Würzburg Residence, one of Europe's grandest baroque palaces and a UNESCO World Heritage site. Continue to Würzburg's historic center for a guided walk.

Excursion: Rothenburg and The

Romantic Road. From Würzburg, travel along this route, which connects scenic towns set among southern Germany's forests and mountains, to enchanting Rothenburg. Be transported to the Middle Ages as you wander down fairy-tale narrow lanes and admire superbly preserved medieval towers, turrets and covered ramparts. At the holiday market, sample the town's scrumptious specialty, the schneeball – or snow ball – a fried pastry dusted with powdered sugar. For an extra dose of holiday spirit, perhaps pay a visit to the nearby German Christmas Museum.

•*Bamberg.* Take a guided walking tour to see the Gothic and baroque architectural gems of Bamberg, a UNESCO World Heritage site. Pass through the ornate archway of the Old Town Hall, built in the middle of a bridge over the Regnitz River.

•*Culinary Delights.* Make your way through Bamberg to taste mouthwatering specialties of the Franconian region, and learn how they are prepared during visits to a bakery, butcher shop, deli and candy store.

Castle. Wend your way down to the town center into Hauptmarkt square to see the Schöner Brunnen, or Beautiful Fountain. Admire the façade of Our Lady's Church, known for its mechanical clock with moving figures, and see the 15th-century St. Lorenz Church.

•*Historical Tour.* In the 1930s, the National Socialist party erected a complex of massive buildings as a display of power for their demonstrations. Visit the Documentation Centre Nazi Party Rally Grounds museum, which delves into the causes and the consequences of the National Socialist reign of terror. Later, see the Palace of Justice building, the courthouse site of the renowned post-World War II trials.

of your day at leisure. Perhaps explore the red-and-white striped stalls of Nuremberg's Christmas market, one of the country's oldest. Be sure to stop at a lebkuchen booth filled with tempting varieties of gingerbread, a perennial holiday favorite for more than 600 years.




