The largest of the three Old Kingdom pyramids in the complex, it was built for the pharaoh Khufu out of approximately 2.3 million massive blocks of stone. Stand before the mystifying, iconic Sphinx that crouches nearby. In the Solar Boat Museum, see a cedar vessel thought to be over 4,500 years old, intended as transportation for a pharaoh in the afterlife. Visit the Papyrus Institute and learn about the ancient process of making papyrus. Relax during lunch at a local restaurant.

Discovery: *Sakkara.* In this vast and ancient necropolis, visit the Mastaba of Mereruka, the Pyramid Tomb of King Teti and the Step Pyramid of Djoser, considered the first pyramid.

DAY FIVE

B I L

CAIRO

Discovery: Islamic and Coptic Cairo. Visit Cairo's most famous Coptic Christian church, the Hanging Church; the Church of St. Sergius; and the historic Ben Ezra Synagogue.

Stop at the El-Nafeza Foundation, a cooperative workshop employing impoverished people, to see beautiful paper being made by hand.

Free Time: Explore the exhilarating and colorful Khan el Khalili bazaar on your own.

Enjoy lunch and then continue to the Citadel, a medieval Islamic fortress complex, and visit the Mosque of Mohammed Ali. Conclude your day at the grand Al-Rifai Mosque, where many of Egypt's modern royal family are entombed.

DAY SIX

CAIRO | LUXOR

Check out of the hotel and fly to Luxor.

Discovery: Luxor Museum. Experience the glory of ancient Thebes as you admire artifacts collected from its temples and necropolis.

Check in to the Sonesta St. George Hotel Luxor.

Discovery: The Temple of Luxor. Drift along the Nile under the graceful sails of a felucca boat

to Luxor Temple, impressively situated on the riverbank. Two seated statues of Ramses II guard the entrance to this expansive complex, built by several pharaohs over many dynasties.

DAY SEVEN

LUXOR

After breakfast, check out of the hotel.

Discovery: Luxor's West Bank ~ The Valleys of the Kings and Queens. Explore this fascinating region where New Kingdom pharaohs and their families awaited immortality. Amazingly, the hieroglyphics that adorn the walls still spring to life with vibrant color. Step inside several tombs, including that of the legendary King Tutankhamen. Walk up the entrance ramp into the striking Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, designed with sweeping, colonnaded terraces. Afterward, stop at an alabaster workshop. See the superbly preserved murals in Amun-her-Khepeshef's tomb, and gaze up at the majestic Colossi of Memnon.

Continue to the pier, embark the Sonesta St. George I and enjoy lunch onboard.



Valley of the Kings

Chicago House

In Luxor, enjoy special access to the Chicago House to see the Chicago House Method of documentation, preservation and conservation. Founded in 1924, the University of Chicago's Oriental Institute's Chicago House has completed epigraphic surveys of important archaeological sites in and around Luxor. The Chicago House Method consists of photographing a surface and printing the image on a coated paper that can be drawn on. After all the details have been sketched, the paper is immersed into an iodine bath that erases the photograph but keeps the drawings, creating a detailed blueprint of the monument and its intricate carvings. Learn about this unique and fascinating process in an exclusive visit specially arranged for you.

Discovery: *The Epigraphic Survey, Oriental Institute, University of Chicago (The Chicago House)*. Enjoy an exclusive visit to the Chicago House, whose mission is the preservation of Egypt's ancient cultural heritage through documentation, conservation and restoration.

Enjoy a belly-dancing performance this evening.

DAY EIGHT

KARNAK | CRUISING

Discovery: *The Temple of Karnak*. Visit the burial place of the Egyptian royal family of the 18th dynasty, which includes a great hall of 134 gigantic sandstone columns.

After lunch on the ship, sail through Esna Lock, then enjoy free time onboard.

DAY NINE

EDFU | KOM OMBO

Relax on deck at leisure this morning, and watch the Nile scenery pass by on your way to Edfu.

Discovery: *The Temple of Horus at Edfu*.

Go ashore to visit this temple, which was built circa 237 B.C. and completed almost 200 years later. Its well-preserved reliefs have provided valuable details about ancient religious rituals and political life.

This afternoon, the ship sails to Kom Ombo.

After lunch, enjoy an engaging discussion with an Egyptologist.

Discovery: *Temple of Sobek and Haroeris*.

In Kom Ombo, discover this unusual double temple complex. The building's symmetrical ground plan unifies two adjacent temples, one dedicated to the crocodile-headed Sobek, god of fertility, and the other to the falcon-headed Haroeris, god of the sky.

Tonight, enjoy a traditional Nubian show on the ship.

DAY TEN

ASWAN | ABU SIMBEL

This morning, the ship docks in Aswan for the day. After breakfast, fly to Abu Simbel.

Discovery: Abu Simbel. Visit the colossal Great Temple of Ramses II, a massive monument commemorating triumphs over the Nubians, Hittites and Syrians. Marvel at the temple's gargantuan size and the mammoth feat of engineering to reconstruct it on higher ground in its present location. The neighboring Temple of Hathor, one of the country's best preserved temples, is equally fascinating. Fly back to Aswan, and enjoy the afternoon at leisure.

This evening, delight in a Farewell Reception and Dinner onboard the ship.

DAY ELEVEN

ASWAN | CAIRO

This morning, disembark the ship.

Discovery: The Temple of Philae and the Aswan High Dam. Board a felucca and sail to the island temple complex of Philae, dedicated to the goddess Isis. Continue to the High Dam, an engineering marvel built in the 1960s, which helps to control the Nile's annual flooding and improve the nation's power supply. Transfer to Aswan's airport for your flight to Cairo. Upon arrival, check in to the InterContinental Citystars Cairo. The remainder of the day is at leisure.



DAY TWELVE

CAIRO | IN TRANSIT

Very early this morning, transfer[†] to the airport for your return flights home.
