In accordance with The Association of Former Students' Bylaws, each member of our Leadership Council must currently be an active member of The Association. Active membership is achieved with a contribution to the Annual Fund of at least \$50. Per our Bylaws, any member who fails to contribute the minimum gift to the Annual Fund, as established by the Board from time to time, will be inactive. Only active members have the right to (i) serve on the Leadership Council; (ii) receive all publications and appropriate program and activity communications; (iii) vote in accordance with the Bylaws; and (iv) such other privileges of membership that may exist from time to time.

## Friday and Saturday Parking

On Friday, Nov. 10, limited parking will be available at the Clayton W. Williams, Jr. Alumni Center. Additional parking is available in the University Center Parking Garage located in the John J. Koldus Student Services Building across from Rudder Tower on the Texas A&M campus. If you have special parking needs, please indicate this on your registration form. Note that disability parking in our main parking lot off George Bush Drive as well as at our Houston Street entrance is first come, first served.

On Saturday, Nov. 11, limited parking will be available at the Williams Alumni Center only for our Leadership Council meeting. **We encourage you to utilize your game day parking, if available.** Vehicles parked in our lot will need to be moved immediately after the meeting.
