Discovery

AHI Connects: Cooking and Calligraphy at Amal Women's Center.

The Marrakech-based, non-profit Amal Women's Center is dedicated to helping disadvantaged women learn cooking skills, gain roles within the hospitality industries, and prepare for financial independence. Learn how to prepare a selection of dishes, followed by a lesson in the art of calligraphy.

Monuments of Marrakech. Explore the Saadian Tombs, the burial place of royals from the Saadi Dynasty. Continue to the shaded souks and uncover local culture while wending the maze-like markets. Then, thrill to the sight of Palais Bahia, the Koutoubia Mosque and Jemma el-Fnaa, a gathering place and performance space for fire-eaters, storytellers and musicians.

Garden and Souks. Witness the Jardin Majorelle, designed by French painter Jacques Majorelle. Visit the nearby Yves Saint Laurent Museum, which boasts a collection of haute couture. Discover the city's delicious culinary scene during a special tour through the souks and medina.

Dar El Bacha Palace. Visit Dar el Bacha Palace to see its display of carved cedarwood and tilework, and enjoy its peaceful courtyard with palm and orange trees.

Atlas Mountains. Journey through a captivating landscape into the foothills of the Atlas Mountains. At a traditional Berber village, gain insight into the history and culture of the Berbers, North Africa's original inhabitants. Join a local family for traditional mint tea and *tafernout*, a delicious Berber bread. Cap of your excursion with lunch featuring a stunning view of the mountains.

Moroccan Feast. Savor Moroccan cuisine accompanied by the music of the Berbers.

Casablanca. Witness the city's elegant buildings and Art Deco architecture. Visit the Hassan II Mosque, one of Morocco's most spectacular religious buildings. Experience city life in Casablanca's central piazza, Place Mohammad V, and see the stunning Church of Notre-Dame de Lourdes.

Rabat. View the impressive façade and landscaped gardens of the Royal Palace, the residence of Morocco's royalty. Witness two of Morocco's treasures: the Mausoleum of Mohammad V and the Hassan Tower. Step inside the Mausoleum of Mohammad V, the resting place of past kings. Gaze in wonder at the minaret of Hassan Tower, rising above the ruins of its mosque. Then continue to Kasbah des Ouidaïas, a quiet neighborhood with views of Sale, Rabat's sister city. Visit the Citadel of Chellah, which has been abandoned since the 1100s.
