OBERAMMERGAU HOTEL

To be confirmed in 2022, you will stay at a well-appointed property near Oberammergau, featuring comfortable amenities.

Activity Level: Activities are generally not very strenuous, but a fair amount of walking can be expected. We expect that guests on this program can follow a guide through cobblestone streets at an average pace for two hours, and walk up and down stairs without assistance. Historic city centers are usually more accessible by foot than vehicle, and sometimes it is not possible for your motor coach to drop you off at hotel and site entrances. Handrails may not always be present, and facilities for the disabled may be limited.





Experience

 With assigned seats in the open-air stage of Passion Play Theatre, watch the fivehour performance (split into two parts with dinner during intermission) of the story that portrays the final days of Jesus of Nazareth, accompanied by a 100-person choir and 55-instrumentalist orchestra.

Explore

- Prior to embarkation, enjoy a scenic motor coach transfer to Passau for sightseeing and a traditional lunch.
- Leisurely cruise the Danube River aboard the Amadeus Silver III, an enchanting, modern river ship known for its sleek design and comfortable staterooms.
- Delight in guided touring of Melk Abbey—one
 of the world's most famous monastic sites. The
 view from the terrace is breathtaking, rivaled
 only by the frescoes, tapestries, and gilded
 treasures inside, including the library that
 holds countless medieval manuscripts.
- Uncover Vienna's highlights during guided historic sightseeing and a cultural tour of Schönbrunn Imperial Palace, the former summer residence of the Habsburgs and a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Accommodating 168 guests, the elegant Amadeus Silver III cruises along Europe's famous waterways with well-appointed cabins, gourmet cuisine, and impeccable service. For leisure time onboard, amenities include a restaurant featuring local delicacies and international cuisine, a panoramic bar, Amadeus Club with library, and a fitness room.

The attractive staterooms and suites are among the most spacious of any European river ship. Suites include a private balcony, and select staterooms feature a window that lowers.
