# Southwest National Parks | Itinerary Highlights (subject to change)

### ARRIVE IN PHOENIX, AZ I SCOTTSDALE Day

Upon arrival an Orbridge representative will be waiting to assist with your transfer to the hotel. Take time to refresh before joining the group in the lobby to depart for Desert Botanical Garden for a special welcome dinner. Overnight: Scottsdale Marriott at McDowell Mountains (D)

### Day SCOTTSDALE | SEDONA | GRAND CANYON

NATIONAL PARK Travel north through the cactus-studded Sonoran Desert arriving at Sedona's stunning Bell Rock Loop. Take advantage of photography opportunities of the magnificent landscape before boarding the motor coach to head into Sedona for lunch on your own. Continue to Grand Canyon National Park—a UNESCO World Heritage Site and a natural wonder that showcases the raw beauty of geological forces over millions of years. After checking into the hotel enjoy the remainder of the day for independent park exploration. Overnight: Kachina Lodge (B)

### Day **GRAND CANYON NATIONAL PARK This**

morning features independent time to leisurely explore the park or join an optional helicopter flightseeing tour of the North, South and East rim. Afterward gather for optional guided Grand Canyon touring to Mather Point and the Visitor Center. Mather Point is a popular and easily accessible viewpoint on the South Rim offering stunning panoramic views. Guests may wish to enjoy a picnic lunch and leisure time at Grandview, a favored spot for anyone seeking a bit of solitude amid the grandeur of the Grand Canyon. Alternatively return to the lodge and enjoy the on-site dining options. The remainder of the day and evening are open for various activities. Perhaps take a guided tour, stroll the Trail of Time or visit the historic Kolb Studio. Overnight: Kachina Lodge (B)

PAGE I LAKE POWELL Departing the Grand Canyon stop at Desert View to see the iconic Watchtower and nearby trading post. Continuing to Page, lunch is on your own followed by guided touring of Antelope Canyon's narrow passages and distinctive swirling rock formations—a mesmerizing haven for photographers.

### LAKE POWELL | BRYCE CANYON NATIONAL Day

PARK, UT Set out on an exciting rafting float trip down the serene Colorado River. Admire various geological features including ancient petroglyphs, rock formations and the unique striations in the canyon walls. This float trip also provides excellent wildlife spotting opportunities. Arriving to Lees Ferry there will be time for a market stop for lunch items and a picnic before departing for Bryce Canyon. This evening settle into your accommodations then rejoin the group for dinner. Overnight: The Lodge at Bryce Canyon (B,L,D)

### BRYCE CANYON NATIONAL PARK I ZION Day

NATIONAL PARK Experience Bryce Canyon, a surreal and captivating landscape of intricately carved hoodoos, towering spires and vibrant rock formations. One of the mustvisit viewpoints within the park is Bryce Point where the magic of Bryce Canyon truly unfolds. Continue on to Sunset and Sunrise Points, each displaying striking geological structures carved over millions of years. After leisure time for lunch depart for Zion National Park. Overnight: Zion Park Lodge (B)

ZION NATIONAL PARK After breakfast set off on a tram ride accompanied by a guide. The remainder of the day is open for independent touring of Zion National Park where your activity options are plentiful. Perhaps take a hike, join a ranger-led program or visit the Human History Museum. Tonight gather with fellow travel companions for dinner. Overnight: Zion Park Lodge (B,D)

### ZION NATIONAL PARK I LAS VEGAS, NV Day

Venture into Zion for a final morning of 8 exploration. This afternoon depart for Las Vegas with time to refresh before a special farewell reception to celebrate your memorable time discovering America's Southwest. The evening is at leisure to stroll The Strip or to take advantage of the amenities at the hotel. Overnight: The Westin Las Vegas Hotel & Spa (B,R)

### **DEPART LAS VEGAS** After breakfast guests Day

departing during the suggested times take a complimentary transfer to the airport for flights home (or to Salt Lake City for guests joining the optional post-tour). (B)

Join a helicopter tour of the North, South and East rim including a flight over the confluence of the little Colorado River. Fly deeper into the canyon viewing immense buttes, majestic temples and spectacular side canyons. This incredible sightseeing opportunity has minimal impact on the nature of this remarkable destination.

Witness amazing landmarks while remaining conscious of the fragility of the environment flying aboard a first rate, environmentally-friendly EC130 aircraft complete with forward-facing stadium seating and a nearly 180° view.


